Be sure to include:

- 1) Title and abstract of the presentation
- 2) Name and email address of the person who will be presenting
- 3) Which category your project most closely aligns with: Environment, Infrastructure, Mobility, or Safety.
- 4) Any additional information you feel necessary

All submitters will receive a confirmation regarding the selection committee's final decisions.
