Veronica Murphy is an Executive Assistant for Special Projects and subject matter expert for the Local Aid Resource Center in the Division of Local Aid & Economic Development at NJDOT. The Local Aid Resource Center is a central source for information for assisting communities with project planning, project delivery, grant application, guidance through the federal process, and other services. She has spent most of her eighteen years at NJDOT working in project development and project management. She is a subject matter expert on Community Impact Assessment and Public Involvement, and worked on the development of the study area's community profile and determining an appropriate outreach program for these projects. Ms. Murphy was part of a team that was tasked with facilitating the safe passage of pedestrians across a busy highway in Union County, New Jersey. The team successfully implemented a shuttle service for the corridor. Veronica also led the outreach efforts for the Pulaski Skyway rehabilitation project. In 2005, Ms. Murphy was the project manager for the Northeast Community Impact Assessment Workshop, which was a collaboration between NJ DOT, the Federal Highway Administration, and the Transportation Research Board (TRB). At TRB, Ms. Murphy chairs the Standing Committee on Community Resources and Impact and serves as a member of Standing Committee on Public Engagement and Communications
