Workzone Safety Checklist:

Are you wearing appropriate PPE, including a hard hat, safety vest, eye, ear, fall and foot protection?

Are you physically, mentally, and emotionally prepared to perform the task at hand safely?

Have you had training/toolbox talks discussing safety as it relates to the work zone?

Have you checked the weather to ensure a safe working environment?

Do you have the correct temporary traffic control devices and equipment for the work to be completed safely?

Is your safety equipment in good working order?

Are you providing clear, concise communication to the public by providing proper work zone notifications and advanced warning?

Is there enough sight distance for the public to react appropriately to your work zone?

Do the workers have protection in the activity area, with all unnecessary vehicles and equipment removed to a staging area or clear zone?

Did you travel through the work zone after set-up to make sure everything is correct and according to plan?
